WHAT ARE EXECUTIVE FUNCTION SKILLS AND WHY DO THEY MATTER FOR STUDENTS?

In order to be effective, students must be able to manage their emotions, sustain attention, organize and plan their work and time, and reflect upon and revise their tactics as circumstances change.

While students typically develop these brain-based skills well into their 20s, the demands they face at school, such as long-term projects, tests in several subjects in a single day, and rigorous expectations for content mastery, often exceed their current capacity to manage them.

As a result, students become stressed and anxious and frequently disengage. They fall behind, not due to intelligence, but as a result of not having strategies to compensate for the Executive Function challenges that most, if not all, students face.



Executive Function skills are selfmanagement abilities that help students focus in class, engage in classroom activities, and perform at their best.
